Like with our recruiting cards, please print these using either Adobe Reader or Chrome, and do <u>NOT</u> print actual size, with the "Fit to Page" not selected. If the "fit" selection is chosen, it prints smaller and doesn't look as good.

Katori Nation Flyers

We are providing different types of flyers to be used in marketing Katori Nation to the public. If you have an opportunity, please print out some copies and get them out to the community.

"Poster" Flyer

The Poster flyer is designed to be hung on a wall, door or bulletin board. It has a minimal amount of text and is "attention getting" from across the room. It is intended to generate interest from headlines and direct people to our website. The poster is not intended to be handed out in bulk or taken home.

"Handout" Flyer

The Handout flyer is designed to be picked up, read and taken home. This type flyer has more information on who we are and what we do. This flyer should not be posted on a wall, but should either be placed in a "Take One" container or handed out. While the handout has more information than the poster, it is still designed to generate enough interest to drive people to our website. We have a full page and half-page version available. Printing the half-page version will save some paper, but will require you (or your child) to get out the scissors or paper cutter.

What to do next

If you know of a local business, community center, church, restaurant, or any other place where families congregate that would be willing to help us, please print a copy of the poster and put it up. If you have an opportunity to place a stack of "take home" flyers anywhere, please print a bunch of handouts and get them out there.



If you can print these flyers on nice paper, that's all the better, but that isn't required. The message is more important than the thickness of the paper. Copy paper will work fine. If it is not practical for you to print these yourself, please let one of the nation officers know about the opportunity and we will work on getting the necessary copies to you.
